OBJECTIVE

To establish terms and conditions for the termination of sanitary and garbage services – exemption to Domestic Waste Management Charges.

POLICY

Exemption from the Domestic Waste Management Charge may be granted under the following conditions:

- The owner/occupier is in receipt of a pension, benefit or allowance under the Commonwealth Social Security Act 1991;
- Because of age, health or well-being, the owner/occupier is placed in full-time care at a nursing institution;
- The premises will not be occupied for the full twelve (12) month rating period;
- A Statutory Declaration from or on behalf of the owner to submitted to Council each financial year;

- The waste receptacles (MRB & MGB) be retrieved by Council;
- The base domestic waste management charge remains.

The following definitions apply to this policy:

Elderly – in receipt of aged pension under the Social Security Act 1991

Institution – registered age or care facility

Unoccupied – not occupied for the full twelve (12) month rating period.
