## **OBJECTIVE**

To determine the number and size of garbage bins and type of material to be removed under Council's normal garbage service.

## **POLICY**

1. Following supply of the mobile garbage bins, Council only collect garbage contained in bins supplied by Council.
2. Receptacles which have been allowed to become objectionable by virtue of being fly-blown and containing rotted, offensive material, will not be emptied
3. Each household is entitled to only one regular garbage removal service per week unless a second service is paid for.

4. Ashes, when forming part of the garbage, will only be removed if wrapped and placed in the garbage bin.
5. Mobile garbage bins containing materials which render them excessively heavy (greater than 65 kg), will not be removed.
6. Council staff collect garbage bins containing garden refuse whether or not that refuse is in bags.
