## **OBJECTIVE**

To determine the provision of toilets at open-space areas for people with a disability

## **POLICY**

- a) Any new amenities block or public toilet constructed by Council contain at least one (1) unisex toilet for people with a disability.
- b) Any major planned maintenance works shall, where possible, include the provision of at least one (1) unisex toilet for people with a disability.
- c) All toilets for people with a disability will be constructed in line with Building Code of Australia.
- d) Continuous paths and ramps will be utilised to enable easy access to all toilets for people with a

disability.

- e) A minimum of one (1) disabled parking spot will be located in close proximity, where possible, to any amenities block or public privy which has a toilet suitable for people with a disability.
