## **OBJECTIVE**

To determine a policy for identification of Community Facilities by signposting.

## **POLICY**

### **Vision**

All facilities for use by the community are clearly identified by signposting which will enhance the image of the City.

### **Objectives**

Signs contain the name of the facility which is clearly visible from a passing motor vehicle.

Signs contain other basic information relative to the function of the facility.

Signs are attractive and enhance the facility.

Signs clearly identify that this is a facility belonging to the City of Cessnock.

Signs bear an attractive logo of the City or a motif representing the Community Organisation operating the facility.

Signs are of a design which clearly identifies the facility as a community facility.

Signs be as vandal resistant as possible.

Signs be as durable as possible (to resist corrosion and UV degradation).

Signs be easily repairable.
