AUTHORITY: Council  
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## **OBJECTIVE**

Removal of graffiti.

## **POLICY**

Council remove graffiti on its own property when resources allow.

Graffiti is removed as soon as possible when it is deemed that the graffiti contains language which is considered offensive, is placed on sites considered of key community importance (eg war memorial, cemetery) and/or is at a site where there is to be a community based event soon after notification of the issue.

Council continue to collate information on the ongoing costs, sites and amount of graffiti impacting on Council facilities and infrastructure.

Council continues to fund the removal of graffiti through budgetary allocations for vandalism and routine maintenance.

Council seek funds from external sources such as the NSW Beat Graffiti Grants Scheme which aim to support a reduction of graffiti within the community.
