

Wollombi Road Upgrade: Community Notice

14 July 2025

Zone 1 Traffic changes to commence 21 July

What you need to know:

- Night works and traffic diversions will occur 21-23 July to install safety barriers
- Construction zone to be established in West bound lanes (Wangi to Hickey)

Upcoming night work and temporary closure of Wollombi Road

- Monday 21 July to Wednesday 23 July 2025 (3 nights) (weather permitting)
- 7pm to 5am

Note: Previously notified nightwork for Thursday 17 July will not be going ahead.



Works: We will be installing safety barriers, completing line marking and

working on two water main crossings between O'Neill Street and Francis Street. Equipment will include hand tools, lighting towers,

excavators and trucks.

Why: The night works are necessary to ensure safety of the public and

minimise overall project impacts by installing the complete road

crossings.

Street parking: From Monday 21 July, you will not be able to park on Wollombi Road

along the construction area as signposted. Travel lanes are being

repositioned to facilitate the upgrade works

All vehicles parked in the work area will need to be removed by 5pm on this day, as from 5pm point newly installed no stopping signs will

be enforced. Please use alternate parking

Speed limit: Reduced to 40km/h in the construction zone

Driveway access: There will be temporary impacts to some driveway access when works

within the construction areas commence. We'll notify affected residents at least 7 days in advance, and let you know how long the impact will last. Following these initial nightworks, it is intended that you will be able to access your driveway behind the barriers. Please

follow the access signage once installed.

Pedestrian access: Will be maintained at all times

Garbage collection: Please place your bins out as usual, and our team will ensure they get

emptied and returned. If any changes occur, we will let you know in

advance.
