City Gateway Entry Signs March 2019



Project

This exciting project forms part of the Hunter Valley Wine Country Tourism Signage Implementation Project.

These City Gateway entry Signs are erected in Braxton, Blackhill and Brunkerville and aim to welcome visitors to our region.



Location

The City Gateway Entry Signs are constructed at three locations:

1. **Branxton** - between New England Hwy & Hunter Express Way,
2. **Black Hill** - on John Renshaw Drive, over 400m west from the intersection of Black Hill Road
3. **Brunkerville** - on Leggetts Drive, eastern side of the road in the road reserve between Leggetts Drive deviation and Leggetts Drive south of Brunkerville Uniting Church.



Design

The design of the City Gateway Entry Signs have:

- a rammed earth wall,
- laser cut stainless steel wording
- laser cut stainless steel mountain feature
- lighting directed.

The design also caters for:

- signifying the entry point
- a long life span
- low maintenance



Construction

Construction of the Gateway Signs are in progress. It is expected to be completed by mid-April.



Timeline

Procurement: September 2018

Construction: October 2018

Completion: April 2019



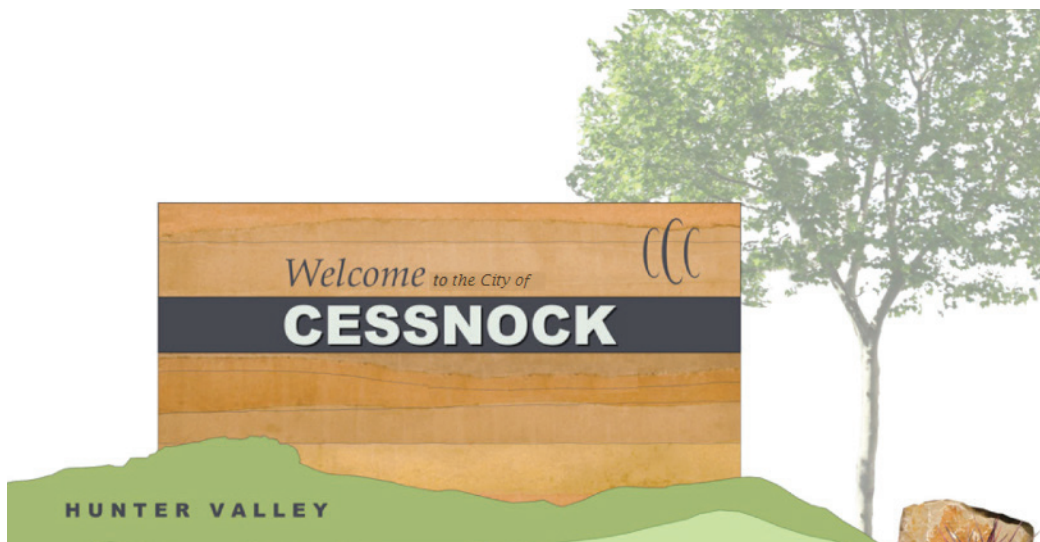
Safety
